

Installing the Agronomy Newsletter Manager (ANM) software, version 4.

There are four steps to completing the installation of ANM v4.

- 1) **Install the software from our website.** Go to our website and follow the links to the ANM software. The direct link is www.agronomy.com.au/anm/ANMv4Setup.exe Choose RUN to install it. It is OK to install over the top of the existing version of ANM on your computer. It will place a shortcut icon on your desktop from which you can run ANM once it has been installed.
- 2) **Send us an email from ANM.** Once installed, ANM will need to gather some information of your hard disk to enable the newsletters to open on your computer. It will put this into an email and will prepare it to be sent to our office. Please send the email it creates. Our office will use that information to prepare a small file we are calling UnlockKey.anm.
- 3) **Save the UnlockKey.anm file.** When you receive the UnlockKey.anm file from us in an email (as an attachment), you will need to **save it to the same directory you installed the ANM software.** By default, this will be C:\Agronomy Newsletters but if you installed it to a different directory, save the UnlockKey.anm file to that directory.
- 4) **Get ANM to read in the UnlockKey.anm file.** When you run ANM, click on “Enter Key”, the button on the right hand side of ANM. That will open a new window and at the bottom of that, you should see a button called “Load from found UnlockKey.anm”. Click on that button. It should then read in the necessary information. Click OK.
- 5) ANM is now fully installed and should offer to download all newsletters, interim newsletters and index files from our website that you are entitled to for the past three years.

Details

Our ANM software will download the newsletters for you and present them in order of newest to oldest. To view a newsletter, just click on the newsletter listed in ANM. As long as you have received the UnlockKey.anm file from us, saved it and told ANM to load it, the newsletters should open.

Our newsletters are now coded with our own security software and will only open with our own pdf viewing software – it comes loaded inside ANMv4. These newsletters will not open with any other pdf viewing software, hence you will only be able to view them through ANM.

When ANM has read in the UnlockKey.anm file and then downloaded newsletters, it will also download information on your subscription and when it ends. To see your subscription status, click on the “Subscription info” button in ANM.

Printing and viewing a newsletter

The 'Print' and other navigation buttons are down the bottom left hand side of the newsletter viewer. The viewer starts automatically when you click on a newsletter to open.

Changing computers:

We have coded the newsletters so that they will only open on one computer. If you change to a new computer, it is a very easy process. Click on the Tools menu and choose the "Change computers..." option. It will gather all the files and information it needs and will copy it to a CD/DVD or memory stick that you can take to the new computer.

When you take the files to the new computer (it should offer to install automatically when you insert the CD/DVD or memory stick into the new computer), after installing, it will need to send an email to us of the new computer's hard disk ID for our office to generate a new UnlockKey.anm file. You can also manually tell ANM to do this by clicking on the "I changed computers" button in ANM. You will not be able to open the newsletters on the new computer without the new UnlockKey.anm file.

Notification of new newsletters

Each month when we have uploaded a new newsletter to our website, ANM on your computer should be checking once a day for a new newsletter and will produce a "pop-up" box when it sees a new newsletter on our website. Click on that to see what new files are there for you to download.

We will also send a short email to you notifying you of when a new newsletter is ready for you to download.
